



Position: College Supervisor

Salary: \$260 U.S. Currency / Student Teacher / Per Placement

Students complete two placements each semester. A college supervisor who supervises a student through both placements will be compensated \$520.

(E.g. A college supervisor who supervises 4 students, each with 2 placements, would be compensated \$2,080)

Benefits: Mileage paid for placements and annual training

Description:

College Supervisors play an integral role in the development and mentoring of future educators. They serve as a liaison between the Office of Student Teaching/Certification, the associate teacher, and the student teacher. The College Supervisor is also responsible for observing and evaluating the student teacher as well as guiding them and their associate teacher through the student teaching experience.

Roles and Responsibilities:

- Accept the student teacher as an entering candidate to the profession under your charge
- Orient and help familiarize the student teacher with classroom routines, school procedures, and staff
- Provide definitive guidelines regarding student teaching requirements and expectations
- Review student teacher's classroom lessons and provide actionable feedback
- Complete classroom observations (minimum 3) and evaluate student performance

Minimum Qualifications:

- Graduate Degree (Masters)
- Minimum of 10 years teaching or administrative experience
- Evidence of prior mentorship (e.g. instructional coach, building principal, etc.)
